Core Health and Safety Training includes; Working at Heights, Confined Space, WHMIS and Respiratory Fit Tests.

Currently we train all of our members in the above courses and we are accredited training providers through the Industrial Education Co-op (IEC) Safety Partnership, which is a Petro-Chemical Industry Tripartite Co-Operative.
