The BCA of Alberta is inviting you to participate in our Alberta Town Hall in order to provide your valuable feedback for upcoming bargaining.

The BCA of Alberta and International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Local Lodge 146 ICI Collective Agreement expires on April 30, 2019.

The Alberta Collective Bargaining process consists of the following:

- REO's determine REO Framework Bargaining issues June 2018
- Framework Bargaining Commences early September 2018
  - Interest-Based approach/collaborative discussion between Registered Employers
     Organizations and Alberta Building Trades Unions on Framework Issues
  - REOs and Alberta Building Trades Unions ("Framework Bargaining Committee") finalize joint Framework Issues in early September 2018
- Trade Specific Bargaining Commences early 2019

Interest-based bargaining is focused on identifying issues and collaboratively working together to develop agreements that satisfy and balance opposing and common interests. Utilizing this interest-based bargaining approach, the BCA is requesting Contractors come prepared at the Town Hall to discuss their experiences under the current BCA of Alberta / IBB Local 146 ICI Collective Agreement with the following:
