APPENDIX "A": ALBERTA (LOCAL 146) REVISED WAGE & BENEFIT SCHEDULE (ATTACHED) EFFECTIVE MAY 5, 2013

<u>Effective May 5, 2013</u>, as per Article 23.00 of the Alberta Collective Agreement, <u>the economic increase shall be \$0.14</u> (less the adjustments to maintain the current vacation and statutory pay levels). Please find <u>attached a copy of the revised Wage & Benefit Schedule for Alberta – Appendix "A".</u>

Effective May 5, 2013, please note the following:

Transportation Rate:

Increase of **\$0.01** to **\$0.51** per kilometre (reflected on page 2 of the Alberta Wage & Benefit Schedule) per Article 19.01. Given the 2% adjustment to the transportation rate, the following travel allowances will also be adjusted by 2%, effective May 5th, 2013.

<u>Initial and Return Travel Allowances will be increased by 2% (rounded to the nearest dollar) per Article 19.01 (c):</u>

Up to 200 km: \$86.00 each way 200 – 300 km: \$122.00 each way 300 – 375 km: \$147.00 each way

375 – 475 km: **\$220.00** each way (or airfare) Over 475 km: **\$337.00** each way (or airfare)

Rotational Leave Allowances will be increased by 2% (rounded to the nearest dollar) per Article 19.05:

300 – 475 km: \$171.00 Over 475 km: \$306.00
