AGREEMENT TO EXTEND AND ENABLE THE EXISTING 2006-2010 COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN:

AND:

INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF BOILERMAKERS
LOCAL 359

In accordance with Article 27 - Duration & Renewal of Agreement, specifically Articles 27:01 and 27:04,

This agreement shall become effective October 10, 2010 and remain in full force and effect until 6 weeks after the CLR-BC has concluded bargaining and the heavy construction industry pattern set.

The parties will meet to conclude collective bargaining within 6 weeks of notification of the conclusion of CLR-BC collective bargaining and the heavy construction industry pattern set.

The parties agree that all the terms and conditions of the 2006-2010 Collective Agreement (CA) remain in force and effect until such time as the parties conclude a new collective agreement following the conclusion of CLR-BC bargaining.

The parties agree to the following amendments effective October 10, 2010.

- 1. Amend Appendix 'A':
 - Increase total wage package by \$1.47 with the following allocations:
 - \$0.10 Apprenticeship & Trade Advancement (ATAC)
 - \$0.25 Pension
 - \$1.00 Journeyperson hourly rate
 - \$0.12 Vacation & Stat. Holiday pay
 - Increase General Foreman rate to JP + 18%, and
 - Increase Foreman rate to JP + 13%
- 2. Amend Article 16:02:
 - Increase meal reimbursement to \$25.00

3. Amend Article 20:02:

- Increase Living Out Allowance to \$135.00 per day.
