# REQUEST FOR SUBSIDY NEW ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT / UPDATED FORMS AND SUBMISSION DEADLINES

This notice is to inform/remind member contractors of the eligibility requirements in order to submit a Request for Funding/Subsidy through the Boilermaker Newfoundland Job Promotion Fund.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- NEW Member contractors and their shareholders and/or directors and/or principals who are either:
  - (i) shareholders or
  - (ii) directors or
  - (iii) owners or
  - (iv) who have control,

either directly or indirectly, of a <u>non-unionized</u> corporation, partnership or proprietorship that is also bidding work, which is the subject of the subsidy application, SHALL NOT be eligible for funding.

- Contractors <u>must</u> be a member of the BCA of Newfoundland & Labrador <u>prior</u> to submitting a request
- To be eligible for funding, member contractors are only permitted to submit bids when there is at least one <u>unassociated non-union</u> competitor who is also bidding

#### **How to Submit a Request for Funding**

- Request for Funding
- Release & Waiver
- Statutory Declaration

### **Request for Funding Submission Deadline**

This is a reminder to eligible BCA of Newfoundland & Labrador Member Contractors that Requests for Funding must be submitted to the BCA <u>at least 5 business days</u> prior to the official bid closing date indicated on the Requests for Proposal provided to Contractors by Owner/Clients. The Trustees require the time in order to properly review the information provided and make an informed decision. Should a Contractor choose to submit a Request for Funding after the minimum required 5 business days, they are risking the possibility of not having their request approved.
