## ALBERTA & NORTHWEST TERRITORIES AND DISTRICT OF MACKENZIE APPENDIX "A" (LOCAL 146)

#### CEFAP INCREASE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010

The BCA has received notification from the Alberta Construction Labour Relations Association that the Contractor contribition rate to CEFAP increased effective March 1, 2010 from \$0.015 per hour worked to \$0.02 per hour worked (including waiting and reporting time).

There was a period of time between the effective date of the increase and the date the increase was communicated to the BCA. For the period of **March 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010** the outstanding contributions are being addressed by the BCA and the Administrator.

<u>Effective July 1, 2010</u> Contractors are required to remit the new rate of \$0.02 per hour worked to CEFAP. This increase is reflected in the revised Wage and Benefit Schedule available on the BCA Website.

### ONTARIO APPENDIX "D" (LOCAL 128)

#### DE NOVO FUND INCREASE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010

During the recent round of collective bargaining the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers and the BCA agreed to increase the current contribution rate to the De Novo Fund in keeping with the increase requested by De Novo and agreed to by other Employer/Employee Bargaining Agencies in Ontario.

**Effective July 1, 2010** the current rate of \$0.02 per hour worked (\$0.01 employer and \$0.01 employee) increased to \$0.04 per hour worked (\$0.02 employer and \$0.02 employee). This increase is reflected in the revised Wage and Benefit Schedule that is available on the BCA Website.
