**ALBERTA - LOCAL 146 – CONSTRUCTION (ICI) AGREEMENT  
2024 TRANSPORTATION AND TRAVEL ALLOWANCE RATES AND  
ANNUAL PROVINCIAL SUBSISTENCE REVIEW/RATES**

**Transportation Rates, Travel Allowance and Rotation Allowances**

Finance Canada posted "Government Announces the 2024 Automobile Deduction Limits and Expense Benefit Rates for Businesses" found at the following link:

Accordingly, the vehicle allowance will increase from \$0.65 to \$0.67 per km effective the first pay period following May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025.

Also initial, return, and rotational leave allowances provide for adjustments to the following amounts effective the first pay period following May 1, 2024:

- Initial and Return Travel Allowances:
  - Up to 200 km: \$113.00 each way
  - Over 200 – 300 km: \$161.00 each way
  - Over 300 – 375 km: \$194.00 each way
  - Over 375 – 475 km: \$288.00 each way (or airfare)
  - Over 475 km: \$442.00 each way (or airfare)
- Rotation Allowances:
  - Beyond 300 – 475 km: \$224.00
  - Beyond 475 km: \$402.00

**Annual Provincial Subsistence Review/Rates**

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Agreement RE: Annual Provincial Subsistence Review, the following Subsistence Allowances shall apply from May 5, 2024 to April 30, 2025 under the construction/ICI agreement:
