Jurisdictional Assignment Plan Contribution

**2025 – 2028 Collective Agreement between Boilermaker Lodge 359 and BCBCA and
Independent Boilermaker Contractors Signatory Hereto (the “Agreement”)**

The Parties recognize that the Construction Labour Relations Association of BC (“CLR”) and the Bargaining Council of British Columbia Building Trade Unions (“BCBCBTU”) have suspended the Employer contribution to the Jurisdictional Assignment Plan (the “Plan”) for the duration of their 2026 – 2029 Collective Agreement. In order to maintain consistency in overall industry contributions to the Plan the parties have agreed to suspend the contribution contained in the Agreement. This suspension will commence on May 31, 2026 and will remain in effect until the contribution resumes under the CLR and BCBCBTU Collective Agreements.
